Chiricahua Circle Winemaker's Guild

The Chiricahua Circle Winemaker's Guild is a private society of 75 families devoted to the success of the Lawrence Dunham Vineyards. They are all wine makers in their souls, and dedicate their time, labor and advocacy to the success of the vineyard.

Chiricahua Circle members participate in the full cycle of the winemaking process throughout the year; Circle members will be invited to take part in the planting, pruning, bottling, harvesting, and crushing of the grapes. As the fruit comes full circle, they will learn about the tasting and blending process of the Rhone varietals produced at Lawrence Dunham Vineyards.

Chiricahua Circle members receive exclusive hands-on access to the year-round winemaking process, and will be invited to contribute to the Circle's private collection of wine-pairing recipes and wine celebration ideas.

The Circle is limited to 75 families who are passionate about the process and mystery of wine. Each founding family will receive a bottle of Lawrence Dunham Vineyard's first release, and will be invited to plant or adopt their own dedicated LDV grapevine during the 2010 planting season.

The cost is \$100 per year per family unit; each year's membership includes: exclusive access to the winemaking process, special tastings and blending workshops, one bottle of the year's best vintage autographed by the Winemaker, the adoption of a new vine in their name, invitations to Chiricahua Circle private events at the vineyard and in the greater Phoenix area, and case discounts of 20% on full case purchases.
